- 1- **It** is either natural (food, flowers, dead animals, plants, rocks, or shells) or man-made (drinking glasses, books, vases, jewelry, coins, pipes, and so on).
- 2- **It** refers to the development of the fashion industry which designs clothing and accessories.
- 3- Around the start of the 20th century fashion magazines began to include photographs and became even more influential
- 4- Charles Frederick Worth (1825 - 1905) is usually seen as the first designer in something like the modern sense, with a large business employing many largely anonymous tailors and seamstresses.
